

Signal Mountain 2011 is more than a youth camp . . . IT IS AN EXPERIENCE!

The world has become a very hostile place and kids today need a place where they can retreat to find peace, fun and friends.

Signal Mountain is the place for your child this summer. Unlike other camps, Signal Mountain is maintained as a Christian camp facility. Christ is Lord over our efforts and management there. Every attempt is made to provide the utmost security and safety for your child. Round the clock medical care is provided, along with secondary insurance coverage for those accidents which sometimes occur to our children. Your family's insurance coverage will serve as the primary carrier in the medical care of your child should they require it.

Attention Parents . . .

Deposits and Refunds

All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable. All requests for refunds must be post-marked no later than No refunds will be given for requests post-marked after this date.

Conduct/Dress:

Modest dress and conduct becoming a Christian witness is mandatory. We maintain a high standard. Only shorts that are reasonable length are permitted. Every day play clothes for daily activities are suggested. It is not necessary to purchase new clothing.

Medication:

All medications will be administered properly by the nurse. Prescriptions should be clearly labeled (send only the exact amount needed for time at camp).

Visitors and Phone Calls:

Since camp is only a few days, campers do not make or accept calls unless an emergency arises. In case of emergency, please call **423-892-4831 xt 104** For the protection of all our campers, all visitors must register upon arrival. Family visitors may cause homesickness for young campers . . . use wisdom! Visitors are not permitted to stay overnight, but are welcome to attend worship services.

Spending Money:

Campers will want to bring spending money. Most will purchase cokes, candy or some other treat each day at the canteen. We recommend, if possible at least \$5.00 per day for canteen goodies. Two snacks per night are included in the Junior-Mini camp fees. All camp fees cover the cost of the block party activities. Canteen cards will be available for purchase at check-in for Intermediate, and Junior-Mini Camp. A limited supply of camp shirts will be available for purchase. Pre-ordered shirts may be picked up in the canteen.

Insurance:

If a camper is covered by parent's health insurance, we must receive a copy of the front and back of camper's insurance card.

Check-In:

Senior Teen, Young Teen, Intermediate, and Junior-Mini: Be at camp on Monday between 1:00 and 2:30 p.m. You will register at the gym upon arrival, then proceed to your assigned cabin. An opening assembly/orientation will take place in the gym at 3:00 p.m.

What to Bring:

Bedding for bunk (blanket, too!)

Bible/Pencil

Soap-Toilet articles

1 Change of Old Clothes

Bathing Suit

Two pair Tennis Shoes (One may get wet!)

Sweater or Jacket

Towels/ wash cloths

Plastic bag for dirty clothes

Do Not Bring: A contagious friendly spirit!

Anything expensive . . . cell phones, jewelry, clothing, cameras, etc. Boomboxes/CD players/IPods and electronic games are not permitted at camp.

Check-Out:

Camp closes at 9:00 a.m. on Friday for Senior Teen, Young Teen, and Intermediate. (Thursday for Junior Mini-Camp).

Campers are to be picked up before or by 10 a.m.

Health-Guidelines:

Attention Parents and Pastors: We will have a NO TOLERANCE policy concerning head lice and nits. Each camper is checked by our nurse during the registration process.

Directions to Signal Mountain Youth Camp . . .

Camp is located on Signal Mountain, Southwest of downtown Chattanooga. From Chattanooga's I-24 West, take Hwy 27 North Bypass around the downtown area until you come to Highway 127. Follow 127 up the mountain into Signal Mountain, Tennessee. Just before the first traffic light, turn left on to Signal Mountain Boulevard. Continue straight up hill to Maryland Avenue (Signal Mtn. Boulevard will bear to the left). Maryland Boulevard will run into James Boulevard. Bear right on James. You will almost immediately turn left onto Timberlinks. Stay on Timberlinks, (past Signal Mountain Church of God). Go until you see Edwards Point Road on left. Turn left on Edwards Point Road. Go about 1 mile until you see a Church of God sign at Hassler Road on your right. Make right turn on Hassler Road. Camp is less than a mile ahead.
